

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT BILL HIRSCH'S DOT-5 SILICONE BRAKE FLUID

DIRECTIONS FOR USING BILL HIRSCH'S SILICONE BRAKE FLUID:

DO NOT SHAKE THE BRAKE FLUID CONTAINER. Avoid agitating the system when bleeding the brakes. Do not pump the brake pedal. Instead, depress and release slowly. Fill the master cylinder carefully, pouring the fluid down the side of the reservoir to minimize air entrapment. Let stand until completely free of air bubbles. Bleed master cylinder if equipped with bleed screws.

METHOD ONE (REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE):

Close all bleeder screws. Start with the wheel furthest away from the master cylinder. Slip a transparent bleeder hose onto the end of the bleed screw and place the other end into a clean container kept partially filled with fluid at all times. The first person depresses the brake pedal slowly (takes 3 to 5 seconds). Then the second person opens the bleed screw. After all air bubbles are out, the bleed screw is closed. Then the first person slowly releases the brake pedal (3 to 5 seconds). Continue this process until there are no more air bubbles visible in the bleed hose. Repeat this process on the remaining wheels, working from the farthest wheel from the master cylinder to the closest. Fill the master cylinder often to avoid reintroducing air into the system.

REMEMBER: 1) Depress pedal slowly. 2) Open bleed screw. 3) Close bleed screw. 4) Release pedal slowly.

METHOD TWO (REQUIRES 1 PERSON):

Attach bleeder hose as in method one. Open bleed screw. Slowly depress pedal (3 to 5 seconds). Repeat until line is free of air. Close bleed screw. Top off master cylinder as needed to prevent reintroduction of air into lines. Repeat with remaining wheels.

- A) Follow vehicle manufacturers' recommendations when adding brake fluid.
- B) Keep brake fluid clean and dry. Contamination with dirt, water, petroleum products or other materials may result in brake failure or costly repair.
- C) Store brake fluid only in its original container. Keep container clean and tightly closed.
- D) Caution: Do not refill container or use for other liquids.
